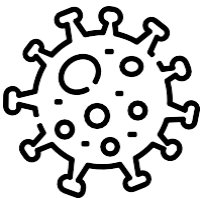
## PARISH OFFICE

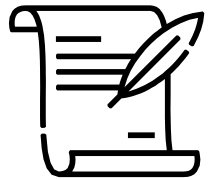

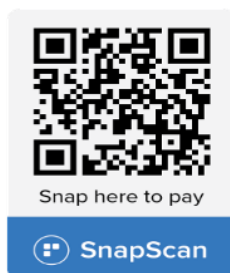
