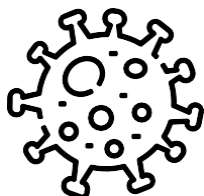
PASTORAL CARE PRAYER CHAIN

PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR CORONAVIRUS

Our public gatherings and worship are important to us. The parish clergy, wardens and staff take seriously the possible spread of the coronavirus. We will regularly disinfect the church before and after each service and have hand-sanitizer at the entrances. The clergy will sanitize their hands before and after Communion. As a precaution during Communion, since we will be using prepacked wafer & wine please just take a glass (do not touch the other glasses). You may also, during greetings and sharing of the peace, you may simply wave. Please always keep social distancing and no group gatherings before and after services. We have received guidelines on Coronavirus by the Diocese's office and will increase measures if the virus become more prevalent in Johannesburg. Please adhere to the regulations always. We pray for those affected and a quick end to the disease.

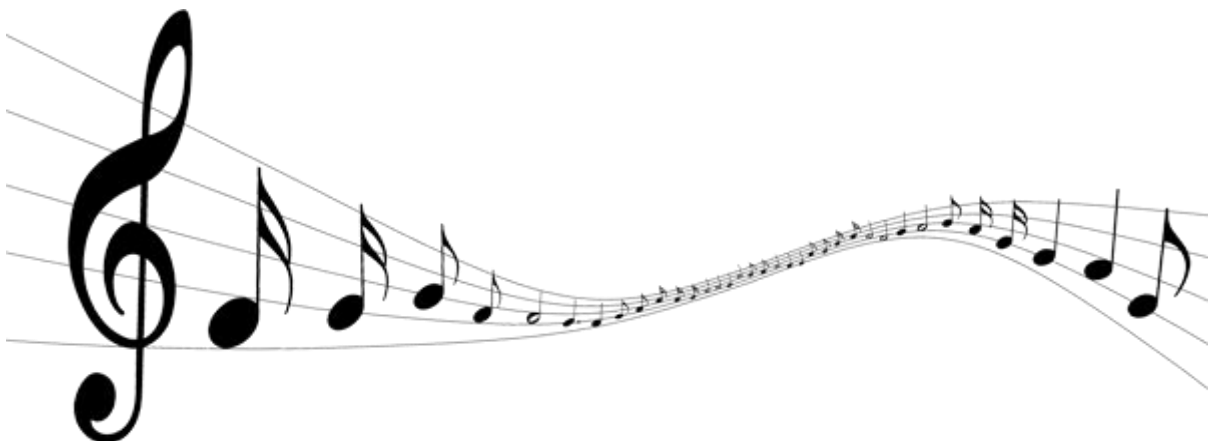
PSALM 99 *Dominus regnavit* *God, the King of the earth*

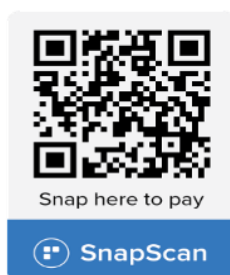
